Dear Residents,

We refer to our previous communication released to residents on 26 March 2020 (attached herewith), where it was stated that no resident is allowed to walk, jog, cycle, etc., on the Estate during the lockdown period. It has come to our attention that some residents are not complying to these regulations as prescribed by the SA Government. Non-compliance leaves the PHOA with no option but to report residents who do not comply with the restrictions. Security will be patrolling the Estate and have received firm instructions to report any transgressors. The restrictions will be explained to first-time offenders but repeat offenders will be reported to the South African Police Service which could lead to imprisonment and/or a fine. The PHOA is in constant contact with the SAPS who have confirmed that they will be policing the implementation and adherence of these restrictions as per the Government Gazette and not by statements made that are not in writing. The Government Gazette clearly states that people are confined to their properties.

The PHOA have not made the current rules. We are merely informing and urging residents to conform to the regulations laid down by the South African Government and to STAY AT HOME. There are a number of high-risk residents in categories such as age and medical conditions on the Estate. As responsible individuals, we should be considerate towards these, and all fellow residents.
